

Traditions of the Bayouland Jamboree

1. The Primary Purpose of the Bayouland Jamboree is to promote sobriety and fellowship with alcoholics, alanons, alateens and others who are sincerely interested in AA.
2. The Trusted Servants of the Jamboree will observe the preamble and traditions of AA.
3. Chairpersons and Committee Members may serve for as long as the Bayouland Jamboree Committee wishes, though new people should be encouraged. BJ Vice-Chairperson is expected to succeed the Chairperson.
4. No individual Committee members will be recognized from the podium, as has been established by Tradition.
5. All attempts to inject commercial interests will be vigorously opposed.
6. During the Jamboree, no outside activities will be scheduled.
7. Only conference-approved Literature will be displayed, and None sold by the Bayouland Jamboree Committee.
8. No Raffle will be held, except for sets of Jamboree tapes.
9. All Money or Property earned by or donated to the Jamboree is the property of those who attend the Jamboree and will be used only for the Jamboree.
10. Labor Day Weekend will be the primary date of the Jamboree and the Theme of the Jamboree shall be "The Miracle of Sobriety."
11. All Alanon, Alateen and Alatot activities, speakers, etc will be organized by the Alanon Family Groups, with overall approval of the Jamboree Committee.
12. All Committee Chairpersons must have 1 year of continuous sobriety when appointed. The Vice-Chairperson shall have 3 years continuous sobriety when appointed.
